



TIMING CHIP OWNERS



TAKE NOTICE!

As of April 2010, the timing chip you purchased from the CCTTA is almost 4 years old. While we expect your chip to last a few more years, we want to ensure you have a properly timed ride.

Prior to any of our events, you may check your chip on the Main Track at the LAP LINE (not the Start/Finish line on Pit Road). Please note that the track will close and must be vacated by all cyclists approximately 5-10 minutes before the first starting time (usually 6:30 p.m.), so plan to arrive early. The yellow box at the Lap Line will beep as you cross the sensor loop. I suggest you stop well before the loop and assess how close you can get to the loop before it beeps. 3-4 feet is typical. Closer than 1 foot might indicate the battery in your unit is low.

If the chip signal is low, the registration staff will be glad to rent you a working chip.
