



Speedway Children's Charities Open Time Trial Championships

Sunday, Nov. 9, 2008 – First Rider Starts 8:00 AM
Lowe's Motor Speedway
Concord, NC



Event

Two TT events will run concurrently on this day:

1. **The Speedway Children's Charities Open 20K Time Trial Championship** – This is the official championship with awards and medals.
 2. **10 mile non-championship Time Trial event** – This event for participants that don't want to race the championship but want to experience the fun of racing their bike at the Speedway. No awards or medals will be presented for this event.
- Both TT events are open to all riders. You DON'T need a cycling license to participate. Please see below for race categories.
- Both events are individual time trials that will be held on the 1 ½ mile main track at Lowe's Motor Speedway
- Riders for both TT events will start at 15 second increments from two start lines on Pit Road.
- Start times and bib numbers will be posted on the web site approximately 3 days prior to event. Start will be in numerical order only. Race will be timed using AMB active transponder/chip. Chips will be available as part of your registration.

Distance

1. Championship TT = 13 Miles (20.96K) - 9 laps of track
2. Non-Championship TT = 10 Miles - 7 laps of track

The race categories for both events include:

Licensed Categories: You must hold a valid cycling race license to race in this category.

Men - Pro/Cat-1/2, Cat 3, Cat 4, Cat 5, Master 35+, Master 45+, Master 55+, Master 65+

Women – Cat 1/2, Cat 3, Cat 4, Master 35+, Master 45+

Recreational Categories: Age-based categories are based on your age on Dec. 31, 2008:

Men – Jr.10-14, Jr. 15-17, men 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85+

Women – Jr.10-14, Jr.15-17, women 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85+

Open – Hand Cyclists - Tandem - Fixed Gear

- Your pre-registration for the 10 mile TT includes admission to The Big Stampede Bike Expo & Swap
- Adult Cyclists – Need Rental Timing Chip - \$ 30.00
- Adult Cyclists – You Own a CCTTA Timing Chip - \$25.00
- Youth Categories - **\$ 15.00**
- Collegiate Licensed Racers - **\$ 15.00**

Championship Awards - Awards and medals will only be awarded for the 20K Championship Time Trial

Licensed Men (Prize money based on minimum men's licensed field of 50 participants in all licensed categories. If less than 50 the prize money will be reduced proportionally.)

- Cash prize for the top three places within combined race category Men Pro/Cat-1/2, Master 35+ 1st \$300, 2nd \$200, 3rd \$100
- Cash prize for the top three places within combined race category Men Cat 3 – Masters 45+ 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$30
- Cash prize for the top three places within combined race category Men Cat 4 - Masters-55+, Masters 65+, 1st \$75, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$35
- No cash prize, medal only - Men Cat 5

Cash prize is for the top three fastest times within the combined race category.

Champion medals for the top three fastest times in each licensed category

A Bonus Prize of \$300 will be awarded to the male rider who has the fastest time and his average speed exceeds the Men's Overall 10 Mile Track Record average speed of 32.12 MPH. To be eligible, riders must race a double triangle bike without any type of fairing. Tandems are not eligible for bonus. No Superman position allowed in the event.

Licensed Women (Prize money based on minimum women's licensed field of 20 participants in all licensed categories. *If less than 20 the prize money will be reduced proportionally.*)

Cash prize only for fastest time within group. Medals for top placed in each category

Cash prize for the top three places within combined race category women Cat-1 & 2, Master 35+ 1st \$150, 2nd \$75, 3rd \$50

Cash prize for the top three places within combined race category women Cat-3 & 4, Master 45+ 1st \$75, 2nd \$60, 3rd \$50

A Bonus Prize of \$300 will be awarded to the woman who has the fastest time and her average speed exceeds the Women's Overall Track Record average Speed of 28.51 MPH. To be eligible, riders must race a double triangle bike without any type of fairing. Tandems are not eligible for bonus. No Superman position allowed in the event.

Recreational Categories

Each Recreational and Open category will race for medals for their specific age bracket. Medals will be awarded to the top three fastest times.

Awards 10 Mile TT Race

No awards will be presented for 10 mile TT race. The 10 mile TT is intended for participants that don't want to race in the championship but want to experience the fun or racing their bike 10 miles at the Speedway.

Results

The race results for both the 20K Championship and 10 miles TT will be available shortly after the last rider finishes. The results by category will be posted and announced at the track. Awards and medals will be presented once results become official. The final results will be posted on the CCTTA web site within a couple of days after the events.
